## Paddock installation – Box: Thursday April 24 - please respect the installation schedule:

## F2-F3 CLASSIC INTERSERIES: Thursday from 1:00 pm

You will receive a sticker by mail, corresponding to your time and place of installation. No installation possible on Fridays.

Outside these times, from Wednesday afternoon at 5:00 pm, competitors will be directed to parking lot G inside the circuit. Competitors must leave the paddock and stalls by 4:30 pm on Sunday 27/04 at the earliest. Those wishing to stay on Sunday evening can park in parking lot G with electricity. Please go to the Pit Building Welcome Hall.

All paddocks and parking lots (except parking lot G) must be vacated by 8:00 pm on Sunday 27/04 at the latest.

Due to the large number of spectators, we recommend that you arrive at least 1 hour before the pre-registration time.

It will not be possible to collect trailers and trucks before 4:30 pm on Sunday. Race cars must remain visible to spectators throughout the event. Boxes must remain open every day from 12:00 to 14:00.

# Circuit access / Pass pick-up:

All guests must present themselves at the Accreditation Center in front of the Hotel Grand Prix Hôtel from Friday onwards, before gaining access to the site. Prefer access via the Brûlat.

### **Opening hours of the Accreditation Center:**

Friday: 7:00 am - 7:00 pm, Saturday: 7:00 am - 7:00 pm, Sunday: 7:00 am - 1:00 pm

Competitors must pick up their passes during the signing on.

#### Paddock:

Cat. 2 (F2 Classic) will be housed in a tent provided by the organisers in Paddock 1 or Parking C.

Cat. 3 (F3 Classic) will be placed in a dedicated area in the Paddock 1 or Parking C.

Vans, trucks, semi-trailers, trailers, tractors, camper vans and other vehicles are not allowed in the paddock. A dedicated parking area will be set aside for them. If you wish to park in the dedicated campsite parking lot, you will need to collect a sticker from the competitor reception desk.

Private cars are not allowed in the paddock and must be parked in competitor parking lot G from Thursday.

Competitors' parking lot = parking lot G.

Multi-car drivers (owners of cars running on several platforms) can park in parking lot C.



























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<u>Pit Box</u>: Keys will be collected from the Pit Building Reception Hall on Thursday from 1:30 pm to 7:00 pm by the first occupant of the stall. Deposit of 50 € in cash or credit card. Competitors are required to leave their stalls open during PitWalk (Saturday from 12:25 to 1:00 pm. and Sunday from 1:00 to 1:35 pm.).

<u>Signing On</u> will take place at the <u>Bureau Accueil Concurrents</u> located in the Pit building hall, on Thursday from 1:30 pm to 7:00 pm. We'll be delighted to welcome you there for the duration of the meeting to carry out administrative checks, collect your passes, practice sessions, participation tickets, access to hospitality etc...

**Scrutineering** will take place in the competitors' structures (Paddock or Box) on Thursday and Friday from 8:30 am. until 2:00 am. before the drivers' briefing. Competitors are required to remain at the disposal of the stewards in the vicinity of their vehicle with the drivers' equipment.

<u>Pilot briefing</u>: pilot briefing will take place on the second floor of the Pit Building at 9.40 am. Access will be via the reception hall.

<u>Testings</u>: on Fridays. It's important to book sessions in advance to ensure space and to take advantage of the preferential rate. <u>Licenses</u>: Each driver must hold a national or international competitor's/driver's license. Weekend licenses (titres de participation) can be purchased at the competitor reception desk. To do so, you need to present your driving license and a medical certificate less than 6 months old. TPNVHCC rate: €190. A TPRL license can be purchased at a cost of €40.

<u>Pour le Plateau 2</u>: 4 pass + 1 parking + 2 driver's club (ven-sam-dim) / voiture engagée <u>Pour le Plateau 3</u>: 4 pass + 1 parking + 2 driver's club (sam-dim) / voiture engagée

Competitors will be able to pick up their passes, including an indoor parking lot, during the signing on.

<u>Transponders</u>: All competitors must be equipped with Chronelec / Tag Heuer Elite transponders or ITS Chrono Cobra 360 transponders on sale <a href="here">here</a>. Rental available from the timekeeper in the pit building basement, at a cost of €60 (Deposit : €300 in cheque or cash).

<u>Trackwalk</u>: possible on foot only on Thursday, April 24 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm (no motorized vehicles, including electric scooters).

<u>Osteopath</u>: A team of osteopathy students will be on site from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday in the briefing room on the 2nd floor of the pit building and will be available to help competitors.



























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TV Broadcasting: The races will be filmed on Saturday and Sunday, and you can watch them on Grand Prix de France Historique. On this occasion, the officials will be vigilant about the dress and presentation of the cars in accordance with the Evin law. We ask you to follow the compulsory sticker plan and to wear the Grand Prix de France Historique badge on your overalls (to be requested from your scrutineer). No cars bearing tobacco or alcohol brand logos will be allowed on the track.
