

Some wise words to begin with

The cars we drive have few inherent safety features. Accidents not only destroy originality but also put at risk the concessions under which we are allowed to race.

Racecar drivers are therefore required to drive in a sportsmanlike and considerate fashion, in particular avoiding contact and not indulging in aggressive driving tactics.



Collection of documents / licence control

Location: Paddock Office, Parking C

Every driver has to pass licence check before entering the track. Make sure you bring all relevant documents. You will receive an envelope with:

- Wristbands to enter the event
- Parking A ticket (car)
- Latest event information

Scrutineering

<u>Cars</u>: All cars have to be checked for safety. For time and location, please see time schedule. Cars are only allowed to enter the track after they successfully past scrutineering.

Equipment: All driver equipment (helmet, HANS, overall, underwear etc), has to be checked for safety. A special desk dedicated for the check of all driver equipment can be found in the scrutineering bay. The equipment has to be conform FIA Appendix L. Time: Thursday 19th of June 12:00 - 21:00. Drivers are only allowed to enter the track after they successfully past equipment check.

Masters Series + GP Formula Time Attack only: Drivers may put the driver equipment / clothing in the car to have it checked for safety.





Drivers Briefing

Mandatory! For time, see detailed time schedule. Location: <u>Red Bull VIP-Lounge</u>, <u>lounge 1</u> <u>above the garages</u>. (first stairs behind pit garages). No or late attendance will be fined by the Stewards with € 250,00 and donated to charity.

Supplementary Regulations

Will be send to the teams in a separate email.

Petrol and Diesel

Available at the Shell station at the main entrance of the circuit, NO CASH, pin and Mastercard only.

Timekeeping

Transponders are available at license check / collection of documents, Thursday 15:00 - 21:00 and Friday 07:00 - 10:00, Paddock Office, Parking C. Your racing licence will be the deposit, rent is $\leqslant 25,00$.

Garages

Garages are only available for selected Masters series teams and Formula GP Time Attack teams, through your championship coordinator. No trucks, trailers or any other vehicles are allowed directly behind the garages. Masters trucks are placed on the paddock located inside Turn 2, across the garages.

Entry to the event

All teams will receive bracelets to enter the event in the drivers envelope at the collection of documents / license control. Teams will also receive either 1 or 2 (different per championship) car parking tickets for personal cars on Parking A.

<u>Paddock Parking Tickets are only available through your championship coordinator</u>.

Teams will NOT receive the Paddock Parking Tickets in their envelope at licence check.

Paddock Parkings are only available for a limited number of support vehicles, <u>no personal cars are allowed on the paddocks</u>.

Team tents

Teams are allowed to break down their tents from <u>Sunday the 22rd of June 18:00 o'clock</u>.

Paddock 1 / garages must be empty on Sunday the 22nd of June 21:00 o'clock

Paddock 2 must be empty on Monday the 23rd of June 08:00 o'clock

Parking B must be empty on Monday the 23rd of June 12:00

Track walk

On Thursday the 19th of June, from 18:00 - 20:00, teams and drivers can do a track-walk by foot. Please note that entering the track is on your own risk. No vehicles are allowed, by foot only.

Protocol for storage of fuel and other hazardous fluids for all championships

- During event days, only a working stock of fuel for one day may be present in the garage, awning or trailer. All other stock should remain in the fuel compound.
- The fuel should be stored in sealed containers, drums or cans.
- The working stock may not be located in the route of forklift trucks or other means of transport.
- The working stock may not exceed 400 liters and must be placed on a drip tray with a capacity of +10%.
- Two fire extinguishers with a minimum capacity of 6 liters and suitable for class B fires (liquid) must be present in direct surrounding of the storage.
- Presence of sufficient absorbents which can be used in case of spillage.

Each team is responsible for the drip trays, extinguishers, grit and absorbents. A daily check will take place to ensure that each team meets all requirements.





Tobacco branding

During the Historic Grand Prix there are strict regulations regarding advertising of tobacco brands. All tobacco brands must be covered during the entire visit to Circuit Zandvoort. This includes expressions on cars, golf carts, banners, information signs, toolboxes, helmets, racing suits, team clothing etc., even when it is visible on historic cars / equipment.



Trailers, race cars, motorhomes and private cars

Only race cars are allowed on the paddocks. Private cars can be parked at <u>parking A</u> (Parking behind Grand Stand).

After unloading, car-trailers and transporters (no big trucks) must be moved from the paddock and can be parked at the trailer parking in the far end of Paddock 2, towards turn 14, yellow square 'trailer parking' below:






Plan sectors, distances, marshal posts Circuit Zandvoort






Paddock Plans PADDOCK 1






Paddock Plans PADDOCK 2

Grand Prix Parade to the center of Zandvoort Saturday June 21st

The organization of the Historic Grand Prix Zandvoort invites all the drivers to participate in the Grand Prix Parade on Saturday the 21st of June 2025.

With this parade we go back to the old days of Formula 1 when the cars would be parked overnight in Zandvoort town.

Important: Only pre-registered cars are allowed to join the parade!

You can collect your sticker for participation on Saturday the 21st of June between 10:00 and 17:00 at the HARC hospitality on Paddock 2. The minimum age is 18 years old.

Line up at <u>19:00</u> o'clock at the assembly area on Paddock 2. The parade will leave at <u>19:30</u> to the center of Zandvoort. The group will return to the circuit around <u>20:30</u>. Going back to the circuit is only allowed under the guidance of an official rescue car and no later than <u>21:00</u>.















Paddock and Environmental regulations

Gas

- Gas cylinders must be secured to prevent them from falling over and being driven into.
- Gas cylinders may not be placed close to inflammables.
- A battery of gas cylinders may only include a maximum of five cylinders.
- Gas cylinders may not be placed in the open air.

Protocol for storage of fuel and other hazardous fluids for all championships

- During event days, only a working stock of fuel for one day may be present in the garage, awning or trailer. All other stock should remain in the fuel compound.
- The fuel should be stored in sealed containers, drums or cans.
- The working stock may not be located in the route of forklift trucks or other means of transport.
- The working stock may not exceed 400 liters and must be placed on a drip tray with a capacity of +10%.
- Two fire extinguishers with a minimum capacity of 6 liters and suitable for class B fires (liquid) must be present in direct surrounding of the storage.
- Presence of sufficient absorbents which can be used in case of spillage.
- Each team is responsible for the drip trays, extinguishers, grit and absorbents.
- A daily check will take place to ensure that each team meets all requirements.

Water

- Any waste water may only be disposed of in a drain and may by no means be disposed of in the paddock.
- Cleaning of cars or other objects in the paddock is not allowed.

Waste

- Any waste must be disposed of in designated waste bins.
- Waste oil must be disposed of separately in designated oil containers. Oil barrels may by no means be left behind in the paddock. Fire prevention requirements

Approval

- In case that more than 150 persons are present in an awning, an application for an approval of "fire proof use" has to be made to the Zandvoort fire brigade.
- In every awning, there must be sufficient extinguishing material in order to be able to extinguish a major fire.





Parking

- Parking, at any time, must be done within the white lines in the paddock.
- Exit gates etc. must be kept free and may not be blocked by vehicles or other obstacles
- No scooters, cars or any other objects may be placed in front of the stairways towards the VIP gallery.

Paddock

- The maximum speed for any vehicle in the paddock is walking speed.
- The minimum age of a driver of a vehicle is 16 years
- Dogs are not allowed on any of the paddock, also not inside motorhomes

Asphalt

• No holes or slides may be made into the asphalt. For any hole that is being drilled, the person responsible will be given a fine of 50 Euros.

Pit garages

• Upon departure, no waste or stickers may be left behind in the pit garage. In case of non-compliance, the deposit will not be returned or a fine will be imposed.

Drones

• It is strictly prohibited to make use of a drone without permission of the circuit media coordinator.
